Overview

The CTE Pathway Scholarship is for students that have completed a Career Pathway during their high school years. This is done by taking 3.0 credits of specific CTE classes that make up the Pathway. CTE Pathways show students a direct connection between doing well in high school and being able to transition smoothly to post-secondary opportunities or obtaining beneficial employment after they graduate. This CTE scholarship is sponsored by CTE teachers, faculty, and people within the community who value CTE.

Eligibility

Eligible student applicants must be a graduating Senior and have completed a Career Pathway with a minimum 3.0 GPA OR a 2.5 GPA with an accompanying letter of recommendation of work ethic from an AF CTE educator. Each applicant must have applied for full time admission to an eligible college, university, or ATC in the fall of the application year. Proof of enrollment is required.

A student applicant may also request to **defer** any scholarship award pending the completion of religious or military service prior to their 22nd birthday. To qualify for the scholarship award deferral, the student must submit paperwork validating any such service which may include military papers or a religious service calling letter. Any amount of scholarship award not claimed or deferred will be returned to the Alpine Foundation.

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be selected by the AFHS Career & Technical Education Cabinet. Awards will be made on the basis of the student applicant's academic performance, attainment of corresponding Skill Certificates, CTSO leadership and activity and other school or community involvement. Also the ability for the student to share how the completion of the pathway and their CTE experiences have helped shape their skill set and future endeavors. Scholarship awards recipients will be notified by mail by **Friday May 4, 2017.** Applicants not selected will be notified shortly thereafter by letter

3. LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION (Two letters are required and MUST BE SIGNED)

- 1. From a CTE teacher
- 2. From another teacher, high school counselor, or community person who knows your strengths and abilities.

4. WRITE A 3-4 PARAGRAPH SUMMARY OF HOW YOUR CTE PATHWAY AND CLASSES HAVE PREPARED YOU FOR THE WORK FORCE, CONTINUING EDUCATION, AND LIFE AFTER HIGH SCHOOL.

5. TRANSCRIPT
